Diocesan news: Due to NSW Public
Health Orders people who are not
vaccinated cannot attend Mass from
October 11th to Oct 25th. Bishop Edwards
has decided that our churches will be
closed during this period of time. He
listed a number of grounds e.g difficulty
in policing this order; long lasting upset
and division among the parishioners;
separating those who are vaccinated and
the unvaccinated; clergy not fully
vaccinated (some parishes would not
have Mass because the priest is not fully
vaccinated.)
